## Report of the work of the Fund 2019

In 2019 the Trustees met in March, June and October to consider grant applications, receive financial reports from the Administrator and to hear about Pax Christi's on-going peace education work from Aisling Griffin. The CPEF gave £10,000 towards this work in 2019.

Like 2018, 2019 was also a time of transition. John Prangley stepped down as a trustee after many years of dedicated service and support which has been greatly appreciated over the years. Pat Gaffney who has acted as an advisor over many years retired from her role as director of Pax Christi. We wish her all the best going forward and are sure she will still be a valuable supporter and friend.

### Examples of projects funded in 2019:

- £240 to Leeds Justice and Peace Commission and Leeds Pax Christi group who jointly held a film screening of 'Voices across the Divide' as part of the fifth Leeds Palestinian Film Festival in November. Afterwards there was time for a discussion on the film and people's experiences of visiting Israel/Palestine.
- A £500 grant to Pax Christi for a Women's Gathering to celebrate International Women's Day. The day brought around 30 women together from across the country to learn from one another and inspire each other with their work for peace. The day included conversation, prayer and sharing and short videos have been produced from the day. The format for a similar day could also be replicated elsewhere.
- £500 to Fellowship of Reconciliation towards equipment for producing 'The Peacecast', a future Christian podcast exploring peace issues.
- £1000 to Student Christian Movement to support them in delivering peace themed workshops to student groups across the country.


